MAC is seeking up to three (3) volunteers to join our Board of Directors for a two-year term. Board members should be willing to commit a minimum of three (3) hours per month to the position.

MAC's Board members are responsible for:

- Monitoring the strategic direction and fiscal accountability of the organization;
- Building the board's reputation and moving the organization forward by demonstrating the principles of Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion in all interactions;
- Participating in monthly board meetings of 90 to 120 minutes;
- Participating on sub-committees as may be needed from time-to-time; and
- Serving a minimum of one two-year term, to a maximum of five two-year terms.

Applications to join the board are being encouraged from those who are:

- Living/working in Mississauga;
- Members of communities that are: BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People of Colour),
 LGBTQ2S+, Deaf, persons with disabilities, neurodivergent, and youth (under 30-years-old);
