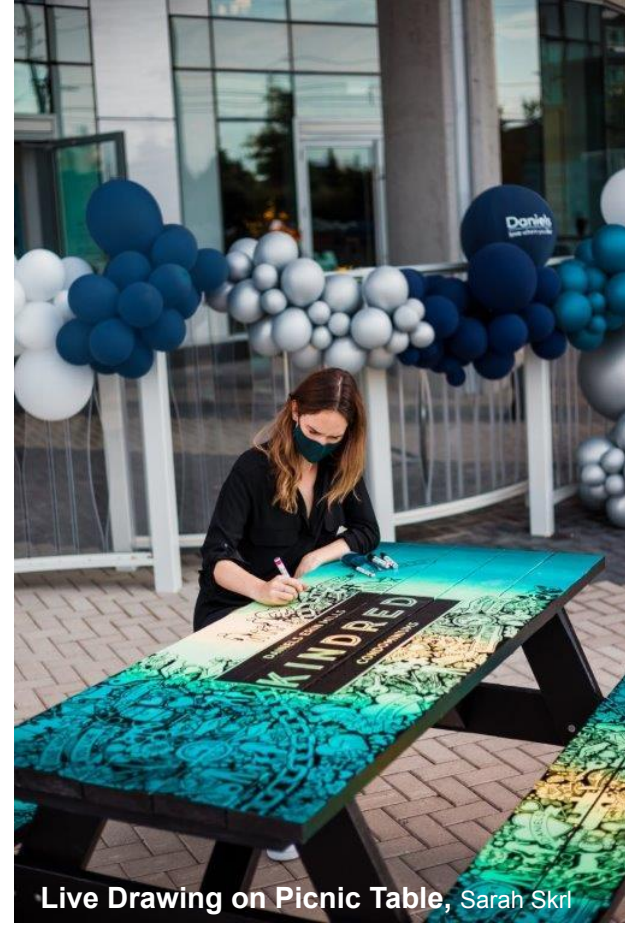

Mentorship | Various Projects

In engagements to date with the arts sector, mentorship was seen as providing a potential bridge toward the inclusion of emerging artists. Atelier has developed a mentorship program to assist emerging artists with:

- **Constructing a budget for a large project**
- **Communicating with clients, and with potential clients**
- **Project management and administration**
- **Considerations related to the design, production and installation of public art**
- **Working alongside and learning from an established artist in one's area of practice.**
- **To gain experience working on a major commission and growing their network**
