





2024 SNAP! - Frequently Asked Questions

How can I submit an application for SNAP!?

All applications must be received through the *SNAP!* webform here: https://form.jotform.com/240036476038050

Where is the application form?

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When is the application deadline?

The *SNAP*! Program will accept applications on a rolling basis throughout 2024. We encourage applicants to submit their applications early. *Submissions will NOT be accepted after November 1, 2024.*

Can I use my own budget template?

No. Please use the budget provided by MAC for your application.

NOTE: If you already have a project budget prepared, you are welcome to include it in the "Additional Document Upload" section if you feel that it better represents your project and provides more context to your application.

Where can I access a budget?

MAC has developed a project budget template for all applicants.

Please make sure to rename your document with your name or your organization's name replacing "YOUR NAME".

Do I need to fill out numbers in all the budget lines?

You do NOT need to have an expense or revenue item for every line in the budget. If a line is not applicable to your project, please enter "\$0".

What does "in-kind" mean?

An in-kind contribution is a non-monetary contribution or donation. This includes donated goods, services or volunteer work to support a project. In-kind contributions can include goods or services offered free of charge or at a significant discount rate (ex. Free rehearsal space, volunteer services).

How much money can I ask for?

Funding amounts will vary depending on the scope of the project, but will typically be an amount of up to \$5,000. Larger funding amounts may be available for projects with a larger budget and community impact.

While this is not a "matching grant", MAC encourages applicants to have additional revenue sources for their project. **Preference will be given to projects demonstrating confirmed revenue sources at the time the application is submitted.**

How do I find my City Ward?

The City of Mississauga is divided into 11 wards, each represented by a City Councillor. You can locate your Ward through the following resources:

Do I need to include a Project Proposal/Sponsorship Package?

No. This is an optional document.

If you have a project proposal or sponsorship package that you wish to include, we encourage you to do so; however if you do not have one, it is not a requirement for submitting an application.

Will MAC review my application before I submit?

MAC can only provide advice on applicant/project eligibility, and submission requirements. We cannot review or advise you on the content of your application.
