Title: Alectra Box on Clarkson Go Station



Overview

The Mississauga Arts Council's (MAC) Murals with MAC program is seeking a local artist to design a mural that will be vinyl-wrapped on an Alectra Bell Box at Clarkson GO Station. This mural will feature bright, colourful visuals that celebrate Mississauga's vibrant spirit, reflect the diversity of daily commuters and special event travellers safely getting to their varied destinations.

The Request for Proposal must be completed by September 22, 2025.

Only Mississauga-based artists will be considered for this project, open to established and or emerging artist(s) or artist teams. We welcome individuals from diverse equity-deserving groups, including but not limited to visible minority groups, Indigenous Peoples, persons with disabilities and 2SLGBTQIA+.

Artist brief

- This mural will feature bright, colourful visuals that celebrate and reflect the diversity of daily commuters and special event travellers, safely on their way to so many different destinations.

Technical Considerations

- The image can be created using traditional (drawing, painting, etc.) or digital techniques
- The image must be available to be reproduced in 120 - 300 DPI, CMYK high-resolution digital format (.pdf or .jpg).
- The image must be compatible with the specifications below

Submission Requirements (by email only)

- ☐ All proposals must be submitted via email with the subject line “**AB25-Clarkson Go**” to jacqueline@macarts.ca
- ☐ All submissions must be compiled into a single PDF document not exceeding 3 MB in size
- ☐ Artist CV and up to 3 work samples, a demonstration of previous experience
- ☐ Artist may submit a maximum of two concepts in total
- ☐ Title of work (important for press release)
- ☐ Statement about the artwork in 150 words or less (important for press release)
- ☐ Artwork mock-ups are encouraged
- ☐ Proposed image(s) in low-resolution digital format (.pdf or .jpg)
- ☐ **Due to the high volume of submissions, only selected artists will be contacted.**

Copyright

The artist retains copyright of the artwork but grants the Mississauga Arts Council and Murals with MAC perpetual permission to use photos and videos of the work for non-commercial promotional purposes. Submitted artwork must not infringe on any copyright or intellectual property rights.
