Fueling creative, community-driven arts projects across the city

Mississauga, ON - November 6, 2025

Mississauga Arts Council (MAC) is proud to announce the 20 recipients of its Fall 2025 MicroGrant Program, which has awarded \$55,950 in matching funds to support innovative and impactful arts projects across the city. This funding supports artists working in all disciplines, including music, theatre, visual arts, and literature, bringing their creative visions to life.

Since 2019, MAC's MicroGrant initiative has awarded \$556,300 to 217 artist-led projects, enriching Mississauga's creative landscape and empowering local artists.

"We received over 50 engaging applications for this round of MicroGrants, each one an artist-led project that was innovative and community-focused", says **Susan Durnin**, **MAC's Administration Lead**. "The 20 winning projects stood out for their uniqueness, thoughtful preparation, and prospects for positive community impact.
